

## Commission Minutes March 18, 2024

The Board of Washington County Commission met in regular session on Monday, March 18, in the commission room at the Washington County Courthouse. Members present were Scott Zabokrtsky, 1<sup>st</sup> District Commissioner, David Willbrant, 2<sup>nd</sup> District Commissioner, and Raleigh Ordoyne, 3<sup>rd</sup> District Commissioner, Diana L Svanda County Clerk to record minutes.

Raleigh called the meeting to order at 8:15 AM followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioners discussed the road sign on the Highway about the six-principal meridian. Raleigh received an Text from Craig Dankenbring about the culverts between 5 & 6 road on Rainbow.
